## How to Connect



Travelers can connect to Colorado Springs Airport's (COS) wireless Internet service using a laptop, personal digital assistant or other device that can connect to the Web and is wireless fidelity compatible.

Airport officials suggest using a computer running Windows ME or higher and newer versions of Palm Handhelds, Pocket PCs or other portable devices.

## Follow these simple steps to connect

---

1. Users must have an 802.11b compatible wireless card installed in their computer or other device.

---
2. Wireless network card should be set to default configuration, or DHCP-enabled.

---
3. If your wireless card network configuration requires the name of an access point or "SSID", type "tsunami" in lower case

---
4. Disable any encryption, WEP, LEAP, PEAP, etc.

---
5. **COS WiFi footprint:** Covers the entire Main Concourse only. There are two small "shadows" in the hold rooms at Gates 1 and 2 created by the support columns at Gates 3 and 4. In the near future, COS plans to expand the coverage.

---
6. Virtual Private Network (VPN) connections can be established using most PPTP client software. However, COS cannot guarantee all of them to work.

---
7. Airport officials recommend that users employ personal Anti Virus software with updated signature files, personal firewall programs and updated security patches or hot fixes for the devices' operating system and browser software.
