AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 101 (DEFINITIONS) AND 104 (OPERATION OF TRUCKS) OF ARTICLE 21 (TRUCK ROUTES) OF CHAPTER 10 (MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC) OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS 2001, AS AMENDED, PERTAINING TO TRUCK ROUTE ZONES

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS:

Section 1. That Sections 101 (Definitions) and 104 (Operation of Trucks) of Article 21 (Truck Routes) of Chapter 10 (Motor Vehicles and Traffic) of the Code of the City of Colorado Springs 2001, as amended, are hereby amended to read as follows:

10.21.101: DEFINITIONS

DESIGNATED TRUCK ROUTE: A street or roadway designated by the Traffic Engineer ~~from~~ **upon** which through travel by trucks is permitted.

RESTRICTED ROUTE: A street or roadway ~~from~~ **upon** which travel is limited to vehicles or loads of certain weight or size.

TRUCK ROUTE ZONE: The area contained within the perimeter created by the closest continuous truck routes as set forth on the City's truck route map. In areas not completely enclosed by truck routes, the truck route zone shall be the area contained within the perimeter created by the combination of the closest continuous truck routes and the City corporate limits, as set forth on the City's truck route map.

10.21.104: OPERATION OF TRUCKS:

* * *

B. Upon the designation of truck routes, it shall be unlawful for any person to operate or cause to be operated a truck upon any other street, highway or other public way. Trucks may deviate from truck routes while traveling to or from a truck terminal, garage, place of repair, place of performing a service or place of loading or unloading, ~~and may proceed from a destination not located upon a truck route to another~~

~~destination without returning to a truck route is to so return would unreasonably increase the distance to be traveled between destinations.~~

When traveling to a destination located within a truck route zone, a truck shall take the shortest direct travel path from any point along the perimeter truck routes to the destination. Subsequent trips from that destination either back to the truck route system or to other destinations within the same truck route zone shall be made from destination to destination or from destination to the truck route system by the shortest direct route.

C. Any person operating a truck upon all or any portion of a street, highway, public way or roadway that is not a truck route, or upon a prohibited route, shall have in the person's possession a log book, **manifest**, delivery slip or other evidence of the point of origin and destination to justify the presence of the vehicle upon the route. Failure to produce evidence upon request of a police officer shall be unlawful.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by the Charter.

Section 3. Council deems it appropriate that this ordinance be published by title and summary prepared by the City Clerk and that this ordinance be available for inspection and acquisition in the Office of the City Clerk.
