

The City of Colorado Springs shall conduct its businesses, operations and services in accord with the law and the highest standards of business practices and ethics. The City of Colorado Springs is committed to complete honesty, utmost integrity, fair dealing and ethical behavior as the basis of its businesses, operations and services to the community.

Complaints; Inquiries. Any person may file a written complaint or an inquiry for consideration by the Independent Ethics Commission through the City Attorney regarding a matter involving an elected official, an appointee including members of boards, committees and commissions appointed by City Council or the Mayor, or an independent contractor. The written complaint or inquiry may only be considered for matters occurring within the last twelve (12) months. Any person may file a written complaint or inquiry for consideration directly with the City Manager, Utilities Chief Executive Officer, Memorial Health System Chief Executive Officer, City Attorney, City Auditor, City Clerk or Presiding Municipal Judge for covered persons within those organizations or for covered persons who work for the City in a volunteer capacity, not including members of boards, committees and commissions appointed by City Council or the Mayor.

Meetings

The Commission shall meet for the purpose of either considering an inquiry for consideration or investigating a written complaint as set forth in Section 1.3.103K of the City Code.
