The City of Colorado Springs Telecommunications Policy Advisory Committee will be gathering information about the city's telecommunications providers. The purpose of this presentation is for the TPAC to gather information about the providers that serve businesses and citizens of Colorado Springs. This information will be summarized in a report to City Council.

You are invited to participate.

The TPAC will schedule 1-2 service providers to provide 8-10 minute presentation about their company and how it serves the businesses and citizens of Colorado Springs. We are requesting the following information from each provider:

- company overview
  - background/history
  - key differentiators - what do you tell your customers makes you different from/better than others?
  - what services you provide
  - voice, Internet, video/cable, etc.
  - business, residential
  - where are the services available (within the greater Colorado Springs area)
  - how the services are provided (facilities/network you have in the area, resale/partnerships, etc.)
- specific Colorado Springs-area details
  - number of customers you serve locally/state/nationally
  - any key local customers you would like to brag about
  - future plans for Colorado Springs (network or service expansions, etc.)
- Issues and concerns
  - challenges faced by your and other providers in the marketplace
  - especially any local or state legislative areas of interest

As a reminder, the TPAC meets on the third Tuesday of each month to discuss telecommunications issues facing our city today. In accordance with the City's Open Meetings laws, this meeting is always open to the public and you are welcome to attend at any time.
