

## **ANNOUNCING THE COUNTY-CITY EMPLOYEE PHARMACY PROGRAM!**

The County - City Employee Pharmacy Program will start filling prescriptions January 3, 2005. The pharmacy is conveniently located in the lower level of the County office building at 27 E. Vermijo and will be open 9 am - 6 pm, Monday - Friday, and closed on weekends and holidays.

You can begin transferring your current retail prescriptions today by calling the County-City Pharmacy at (719) 520-7590, or by completing a Transfer Request Form. This form is available on-line at [springsgov.com/Benefits Information/Prescription Program/Maxor-2005](http://springsgov.com/Benefits%20Information/Prescription%20Program/Maxor-2005). Click on the Prescription Transfer Request Form.

Walgreens Health Initiative has already sent a file to Maxor for current mail order prescriptions. You can request a mail order refill by calling the Automated Refill Line at 1-800-573-6214.

Prescriptions can be picked up at the pharmacy, mailed to your home, or delivered to you via inter-office mail.

Co-pays for a 30-day prescription filled at the County-City Pharmacy are FREE in January. You will receive credit toward a 90-day mail order supply.

Prescriptions obtained after January 2005 that are to be delivered by mail or Inter-Office delivery, require that:

- Your credit card be on file in the County-City Pharmacy

Or

- A check to cover the amount of your co-pay accompany your refill request
