DESCRIPTION: **SIGNALIZED LOCATION TREATMENT STUDY TO INCLUDE IDENTIFICATION OF UN-NEEDED TRAFFIC SIGNALS FOR REMOVAL:** The purpose of this project is to develop a systematic approach to prioritizing the City's signalized locations for review, refining the two policies (Exhibits 5 and 6) used in the review and analysis of the subject locations (Traffic Signal Removal and Traffic Signal Program policies), identification of additional policies needed, and lastly to review subject signalized locations (Exhibit 7) for the determination of the appropriate intersection control. While there is a fiscal benefit to removing traffic signals, particular attention must be paid to all direct and indirect benefits/costs of said signal. These could include (but are not limited to) effects of travel delay to all users of the intersection/crossing, changes to existing accident rates and types, and voluntary re-routing of traffic to utilize another location to access (or cross) the roadway system
